how to apply

application procedures for College Launch students

- **College Launch Application**

Complete and send to Grace College Indianapolis.

- **High School Transcripts Request Form (enclosed)**

Complete the top portion and forward it to your guidance counselor or home-school administrator. The counselor will complete the remainder of the form and return it along with a copy of your official high school transcripts directly to Grace College Indianapolis.

- **Program Conditions (enclosed)**

Read thoroughly, sign, and return to Grace College Indianapolis.

purpose

College Launch was created to help high school students earn dual credit in their courses, so that their college expenses would be less in the future. Students can join College Launch on a full-time or half-time basis.

recommended criteria

Students who have at least a 3.0 GPA and are in good standing at their high school or home school are permitted to enroll in the associate degree program at Grace College Indianapolis.

fees

Full-time College Launch students pay the full cost of the associate degree program, and half-time students pay half of the cost of the associate degree program.

PROGRAM CONDITIONS**

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Full-Time College Launch

- Full-time College Launch students may start as a senior in high school and take one year to complete the first year of the associate degree program.
- The intent is that he/she will then complete the second year of the associate degree.
- Full-time College Launch students take two classes each session as determined by the site director. Students are required to pay the full cost of the associate degree program.

Half-Time College Launch

- Half-time College Launch students may start as a junior in high school and take two years to complete the first year of the associate degree program.
- The intent is that he/she will continue as a half-time College Launch student while a senior in high school and then go on to complete the second year of the associate degree once he/she is finished with high school.
- Half-time College Launch students take one class each session as determined by the site director. Students are required to pay half of the cost of the associate degree program.

Program Conditions

- Classes are only offered during scheduled times and are set according to the needs of Grace College Indianapolis. Class selection and schedule cannot be altered to accommodate the needs of the student's high school schedule.
- Attendance at Grace College Indianapolis is required. It is the student's responsibility to make sure there are no conflicts.
- Students who graduate from high school during the College Launch program must complete the college admissions process. Although this changes the status of the student for college purposes, the student will not notice any difference.
- Financial aid is not available for College Launch students.
